Learn-to-Sew Camp for Beginners

Description: This is a **one-day camp** in which students will learn the parts of the sewing machine; how to pin and cut fabric; how to straight stitch, and pivot. In this camp students will make a tote bag for carrying their supplies for future camps.

This camp is required for all students with no sewing experience. Once completed students may sign up for as many other camps as they like. Sewing machines, tools and supplies are provided.

Craft Sewing Camp

Description: During this camp week, students will make as many different fabric crafts as time allows. Projects include a tie blanket, fringe pillow, back pack, pencil case, pod pouch, and stuffed animals.

Pajama Party Camp

Description: During this camp week, students will make a pair of pajama pants, a sleep shirt, slippers and pillowcase using easy-to-sew sewing patterns. Previous sewing experience is recommended.

Me & My Dolly Pajama Party Camp

Description: This camp is designed for 18" dolls like the American Girl® doll. Projects include a pajama dress and pant, slippers, and sleeping bag with drawstring carrying case.
